

# TASMAN SECONDARY SCHOOLS SKATEBOARDING CHAMPIONSHIPS 2012

## EVENT INFORMATION

- Date** Saturday March 24
- Time** 10.00am
- Venue** Neale Park skate park, Nelson
- Entry** Entries must go through school Sport Coordinators and close **Friday March 16, absolutely NO entries on the day**
- \$5 per participant – schools will be invoiced after the event.
- Depending on the number of entries, there may be a limit imposed
- Grades** Junior Boys (Year 9 and 10)  
Open Boys (Years 9-13)  
Open Girls (Years 9-13)
- Format** Judged competition with each competitor allowed two 1 minute runs on the skate park. Competitors will be judged on the following criteria: VARIETY, CONSISTENCY, STYLE and DIFFICULTY

### Heat Rounds

- Each contestant will have 2 x 1 minute runs on the circuit
- In each group, all contestants will have one round each, then will complete their second round
- The highest score out of both rounds will be recorded on the leaderboard
- The top 6 contestants at the end of the heats will compete in the finals

### Finals Round

- The top 6 contestants from each age group will be eligible for the finals round.
- Each finalist will be given 2 x 1 minute runs at the circuit.
- Points will not be carried over from the pool round.
- The winner will be the highest points scorer at the end of the finals round.

There will be an award for the most successful school team.

The team award will be determined from the 4 most successful athletes from each school. From the individual rounds, athletes will gain points based on their rankings. The top 4 from your school will be added together to determine the most successful team. (This is across all grades – so your top 4 may be one athlete from each category, or 3 junior boys and 1 girl)

### Clothing

It is up to the school what clothing they allow their students to wear. Many students are likely to want to wear jeans. A reminder that these are considered an item of safety clothing to protect from grazes etc.

Safety equipment such as helmets, wrist guards and knee pads etc are not compulsory, but it is recommended they be used

### Officials

Cheapskates Nelson are providing the judges for the day

A minimum of one Team Manager per school must supervise their School Team and is responsible for the students

Team Managers may be requested to assist with marshalling for a time on the day. Sports Coordinators, please make managers aware of this.

### First Aid

Triple One Care will be on site providing first aid but schools are asked to bring their own basic first aid kits

### Prizegiving

On completion of the event the top individual placings will be announced from each category and the most successful school team awarded.
